We hope you will remember these moments of great emotion. You will then find the pre-program for the 2022 edition which will take place from June 23rd to June 26th.

This new edition will be faithful to tradition, all the concerts will take place at the castle.

Thursday, the music of the beginning of the 20th century will dominate with Jean Françaix, Zemlinsky and Gershwin, and we will discover an Austrian post-romantic musician: Ludwig Thuille. Friday evening will be devoted to Schubert. Saturday's promenade concert will follow tradition, with major works by Richard Strauss and Mozart, the same Mozart who will conclude this edition on Sunday morning.

And there will be two new features:

- Singing makes its debut at Bonheur Musical thanks to the presence of Bryan Benner, a brilliant American musician, living in Vienna who will sing Schubert's Lieder to us on Thursday evening, accompanying himself on the guitar and, to end the concert promenade on Saturday , he will sing Neapolitan songs around the basin. Bryan is very successful in Austria, Germany, the Balkans, Greece and the United States. It will be his first appearance on a French stage.

- Another novelty: Saturday morning, at a time to be specified later, Le Bonheur Musical will make room for young artists: we will have the pleasure of welcoming a cellist, Antonia Straka and a pianist, Sabina Hasanova, both at the threshold of very important careers.

Many moments of happiness await us, without forgetting the pleasure of finding ourselves in the ideal setting of the castle.

In February, we will send you a dossier with information on little-known composers and our new artists.

Until then, I wish you happy holidays and a happy new year 2022.


